# Politics & Public Diplomacy in Contemporary Russia

Designed to give participants new insights into the country today, Politics & Public Diplomacy explores regional developments and conflict, economic and political reforms under Putin, and new cultural phenomena shaping today's Russia.

## ACADEMIC PROGRAM

Coursework provides participants greater insight into Russia's political role in the global arena. Classes are taught in English, and cover such topics as regional conflict, elections and opposition figures, and economic policy and sanctions.

Russian language classes are provided for participants at all levels, including those with no prior study of Russian. Participants earn 8 - 10 U.S. academic credit hours in political science and Russian studies through Bryn Mawr College.

## SUPPORT SERVICES

American Councils conducts an informative pre-departure orientation and employs a full-time resident director in Moscow. Participants also receive comprehensive overseas health, accident, and evacuation insurance.
